- Rome, Han China, & Mauyran/Gupta India (2010)

- Silk Roads, Indian Ocean trading network, Sahara trade routes

- Exploration done by the Portuguese versus the Spanish
- Colonization (Great Britain & France versus Spain & Portugal)
- The Role of women in different regions (i.e. Europe, Asia, etc.) between 700 – 1450
(2011 alternate)
- The Columbian Exchange and the Silk Roads
- The Atlantic slave trade with slavery in the Islamic World

- Feudalism / social structures in Europe (Middle Ages) to Japan (Tokugawa Shogunate)
- Contacts with European (1450 through 1750) in Asia, Africa, Americas
- The Ottoman, Spanish, & Russian Empires during 16th & 17th centuries
- Revolutions in France, Haiti, and the United States
- Independence movements in Mexico, U.S., Brazil, and Spanish speaking parts of South America

- Political, social, and economic developments in North America & Latin America during the 19th century

- Western Imperialism in Africa and Asia

- 19th century European imperialism in Africa / Asia with the previous European colonialism of the Americas
