- North India

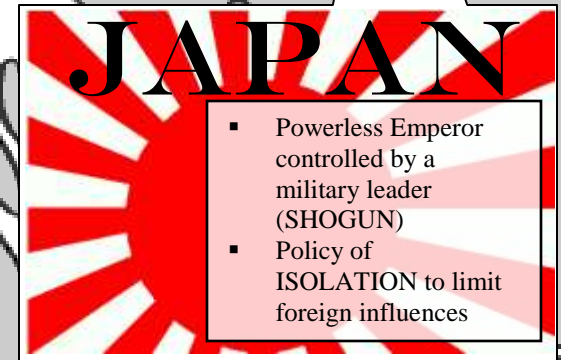
### CONTRIBUTIONS:
